Curriculum/Pupil Free Day- Monday September 10

On Monday we continued our work with writing and the focus was assessment of student writing using the NAPLAN Writing Marking Guide 2018 (Persuasive and Narrative). Writing is set to be one of the goals of the next School Strategic Plan and the staff worked with Mrs Vivien Smith who has worked across the system and particularly as a Principal in Melbourne and Canberra schools. Vivien focussed on assisting the teaching staff to build their capacity to more effectively unpack school writing data; in particular the NAPLAN 2018 data as well as building their capacity to know exactly where the students are currently at and to plan and articulate what the next stage of learning will be. We all had a collegial day continuing our learning journey with effective practice in teaching young writers. We finished the day with an extended understanding and more consistency in vocabulary when talking about assessment of writing as well as a greater knowledge about 'what to teach', 'who to teach it to' and 'how to teach it' building the connectors between the WHAT, WHO and HOW. This assists us as practitioners to have greater continuity, common language and to build collective understanding, so that we can best support students more effectively in the classroom.

School Council President Report

Hello families,

I hope you are all enjoying the lovely spring weather! Term three has been packed with PFA fundraisers, building works and community events. We appreciate everyone's patience during the Gymnasium build and are just waiting for some final work to be completed before officially opening it!

We were of course thrilled by Education Minister James Merlino's recent election promise to provide a further \$4.5 million for more building upgrades at Tucker Road. A huge thank you to Member for Bentleigh, Nick Staikos and our staff and community members who have worked to achieve this!

The main thing I wanted to talk about this month is the school review, which was completed in August. As a parent it was so interesting to be involved in this process. The review team was made up of an independent reviewer, Education Department representatives and school leadership, including the year level coordinators. We combed through huge amounts of data to analyse the schools strengths and weaknesses and begin to form a plan for the next four years. It was fantastic to see such a dedicated team of experts working to improve our school. Another highlight that I wanted to share was the fantastic feedback the external panel members gave about our students. They were so impressed by their respectful manner and talked about what articulate, motivated, thoughtful and kind children we have at Tucker Road.






