Welcome to Term 4 Week 9 Class Structure for 2018

Student Numbers, Staffing and Class Structure for 2018

We will have approximately 637 students and there will be 27 classes in total across the school.

The class structure model is as follows:

Year Prep/Foundation: 5 classes

Year 1: 5 classes

Year 2: 4 classes

Year 3: 3 classes + 1 x Year 3/4 class

Year 4: 3 classes

Year 5 and 6: 6 x Year 5/6 classes

The staff have collectively agreed through consultative processes, about the class structure for 2018 and this model will include 6 classes of 5/6. This decision was explained at an information evening held last night which was hosted by Rachel Kushnir (5/6 Team Leader) and supported by current years 5/6 and 3/4 staff. The meeting was well attended and supported by many parents/carers. Rachel informed the community regarding the general expectations across the year level and how the 5/6 unit will function in 2018 as well as research around composite classes. The reasons for the decision to have 5/6 composite classes was not made lightly and staff were diligent in considering all of the social, emotional and educational needs of the current year 4 and 5 children. The reasons presented and explained by staff for this decision were extremely valid. Rachel and the team answered any concerns raised by parents/carers. Thank you to everyone who attended and supported our professional decision.

Information evenings to explain more about the curriculum, homework, wellbeing practices, camps and special events for each of the year level will be hosted early 2018.

Class Allocations and Reports

Teachers have been very busy finalising the allocation of children to classes. Thank you to all of the parent/carers from who I have received requests. We have endeavoured to attend to requests in accordance with the criteria mentioned in previous newsletters. Please understand that it is not possible to take any new requests as we intend to have the classes for 2018 finalised by the end of this week. Teachers are presently finalising reports ready to go out on Compass. More details are included in this newsletter.

'Step Up' afternoon.

On Tuesday the students went to visit the next year level classes and enjoyed some activities with the current 2017 year level teachers. The children spoke positively, had a great chat with the teachers and enjoyed the experience. They will all meet their 2018 teacher on Thursday December 21.

It was very exciting when Wurundjeri Elder Colin Hunter started our festival with a Welcome (Wominjeka) to Country ceremony which was very engaging for the students to watch. All students, staff and guests received a gum leaf to carry around in their pockets for the day, knowing they were truly welcome on the land and will treat it with care and respect.

We would really like thank Colin as well as his colleagues, Rebecca and Brooke (Wurundjeri women & field representatives) who presented workshops and stories for the children to enjoy and learn more about the traditional custodians of Melbourne and surrounding lands. It was a pleasure to listen to Rebecca and Brooke teach us about their culture, history, language (*Woiwurrung*), stories, and how to survive on land without electricity, cars, iPads, computers and supermarkets. It was an amazing day and we hope to build respectful relationships that last well in to the future.

Thank you Wurundjeri Tribe Land Council for helping to organise this event alongside Ms Robyn Donoghue. Thank you to the school community members who attended to support the Welcome to Country ceremony. It was a fabulous community event to start off our week!

Child Safe Standards – TRBPS Student Wellbeing and Engagement Policy 2017

As mentioned in past newsletters, the Victorian Government is committed to the safety and wellbeing of all children and young people. As part of the Victorian Government's commitment to implementing the recommendations of the 'Betrayal of Trust' report, which found that more must be done to prevent and respond to child abuse in our community. There is a new regulatory landscape surrounding child safety, underpinned by the new PROTECT Child Safe Standards. As part of The Child Safe Standards introduced by the Government last year we have been focusing on Standard 7 'Strategies to Promote Child Empowerment and Participation'. We have provided a copy of the flyer in this newsletter. The Child Safe Standards have been incorporated in the development of our codes of conduct and protocols and procedures when dealing with children for all TRBPS community members and visitors. These standards also underpin our new 'Student Engagement and Wellbeing Policy - 2017' which was ratified this year by School Council, after staff and community consultation. You can locate this policy via Compass.

The Year 6 Graduation Ceremony and Special Fun Evening are fast approaching.

The more formal Graduation Ceremony will take place this year at Bentleigh Secondary College on Wednesday December 13 from 7.00 – till approximately 9.00pm. Tucker Road Bentleigh Primary School Qkr for the Canteen

Back in Term 2 TRBPS launched the use of the QKR by MasterCard! Payment App as a way parents can make safe and secure payments to the school. 75% of families have registered to use the app and many have become accustomed to paying for Canteen, Uniform, Excursions/Activities and School Contributions in this manner.

You will notice that all our notices are offering Qkr as an option for payment as this reduces the amount of cash handling and helps to reduce risk in the office.

As part of commitment to introduce efficiencies and reduce risk, we ask that as from 5th December all Canteen orders are submitted by using the Qkr App.

This will mean that you can use the system to lodge orders from home without having to find the correct change and that Marilyn Green (Canteen Operator) and her volunteers can use the system to prepare your child's lunch.

Users of the Qkr App will no longer be required to send a paper bag for their lunch, the Canteen will supply these as part of the order.

We understand that some will find it difficult to use the Qkr app and we will work to accommodate

Casual cash purchases of items such as Icy-Poles, will still be permitted at recess and Lunch times.

The instructions for installing Qkr are attached to this notice, I encourage you to Register the Qkr App and enjoy what it has to offer.

If you are not sure about Qkr ask other parents what they think.

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

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
