Attitudes to School Survey 2017

The annual Attitudes to School Survey provides an opportunity for students to have a say and provide feedback to the school. We value student voice as a means to improving student engagement, wellbeing and quality instruction and are conducting a survey to find out what your child thinks of our school. The Attitudes to School survey is an annual survey offered by the Department of Education and Training to assist schools in gaining an understanding of students' perceptions and experience of school. Our school will use the survey results to plan programs and activities to improve your child's schooling experience.

The Department has updated the survey for 2017 to include important new measures that are known to influence student engagement and performance. Students from Year 4 to Year 6 at our school will participate in the survey. Your child will complete the survey online during school hours using a purpose built secure online survey tool. It is important to note that we are not in any way "testing" your child. Your child has the right to refuse or withdraw from the survey at any point before, during, or after completion of the survey.

The survey results will be reported back to the school in term 3. No student can be identified in the results reported to schools or in any other report of the data. School survey results will be communicated to parents through annual reporting to parents and discussed at School Council. Last year we used the survey results to plan further development of the SRC, the student leadership program; including the implementation of Student Peacemakers to help younger students in the yard. The staff discussed playground and safety issues including the need to increase the number of teachers on duty at each break time. We redesigned yard duty areas to increase safety and visibility. We used the data results to improve student wellbeing programs to incorporate a stronger focus on the explicit teaching of social skills through circle time and restorative practices.

This year the Attitudes to School survey will be conducted at our school over the period Monday 22 May to Friday 9 June. The survey only takes 20-30 minutes to complete and occurs during your child's class time.

REMINDER Camps, Sports and **Excursions Fund**

The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund helps ensure that no student misses out on the opportunity to join their classmates for important, educational and fun activities. It is part of making Victoria the Education State and the Government's commitment to breaking the link between a student's background and their achievements.

CSEF will be provided to eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF. A special consideration category also exists for asylum seeker and refugee families. The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

The annual CSEF amount per student is:

- \$125 for primary school students
- \$225 for secondary school students


